1.2 Significance of the study

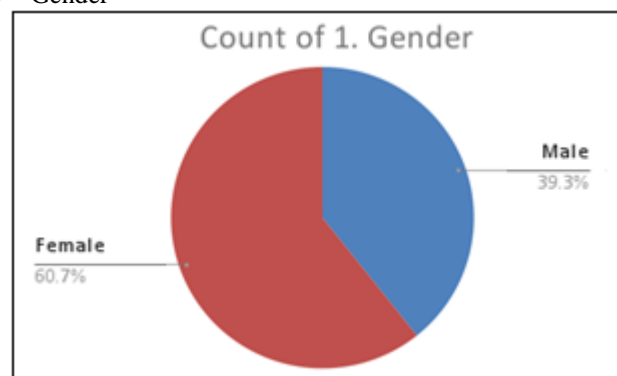
This study mainly focus on what are the challenges faced by the college students while to adapt in new normal method of learning

• Gender



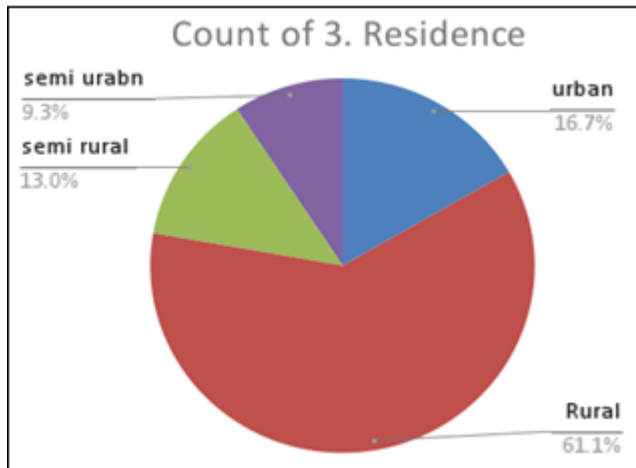
The data is collected from 100 Graduate Students, There were 60.7% Female students & 39.3% male students

• Residence of Students



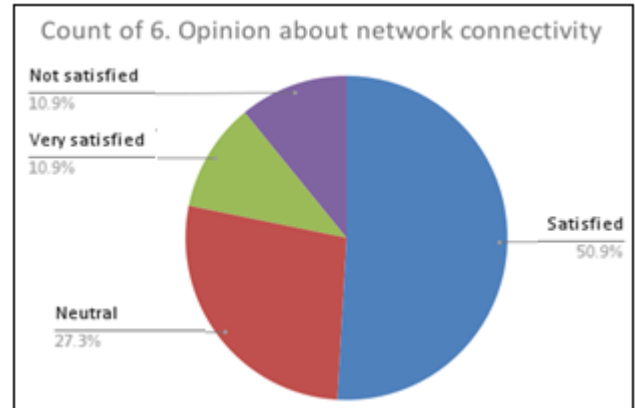
The chart shows Majority of the students are from rural area 16.7% of students they were live urban area, below 10% of students belongs to semi urban

• Opinion about Network connectivity

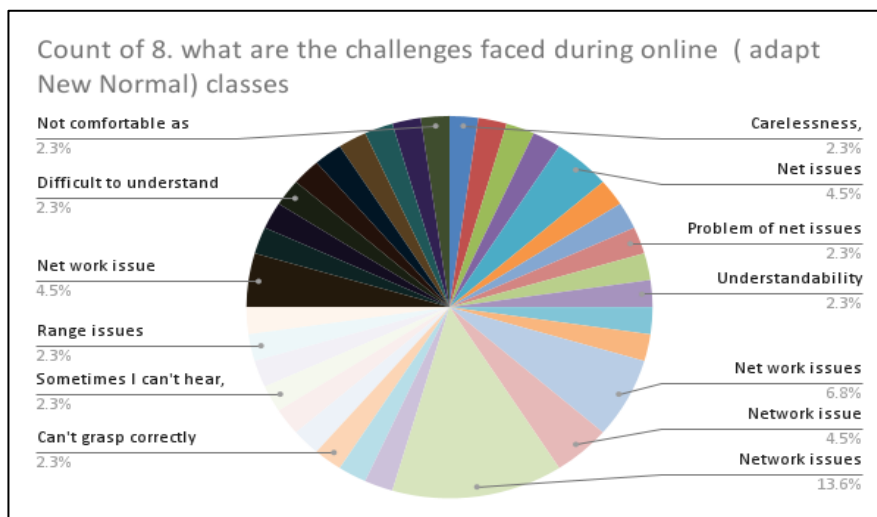


It was concluded that among the respondents most of them satisfied with net work connectivity.27.3% of students have neutral level in net work connectivity

• What are the platforms used for E Learning

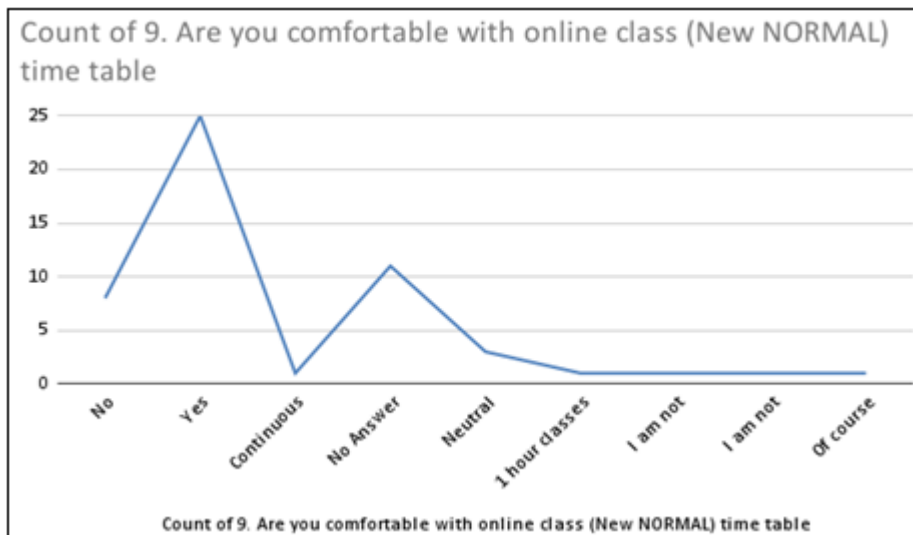
Most of the students preferred Google Meet because Google meet is widely accepted.

Lots of challenges were faced by students while adapting new normal, online classes are difficult to understand some of the students feel uncomfortable with online classes, Network issue is an another big challenge

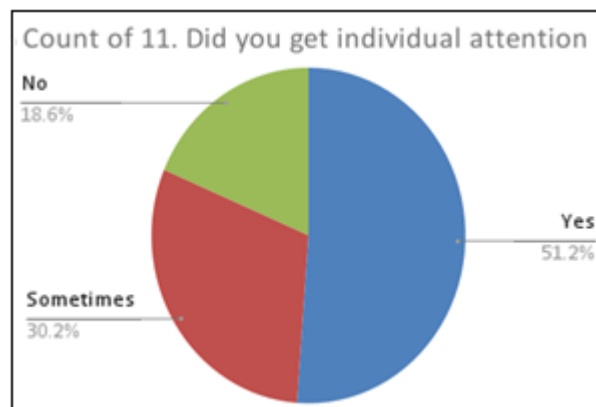
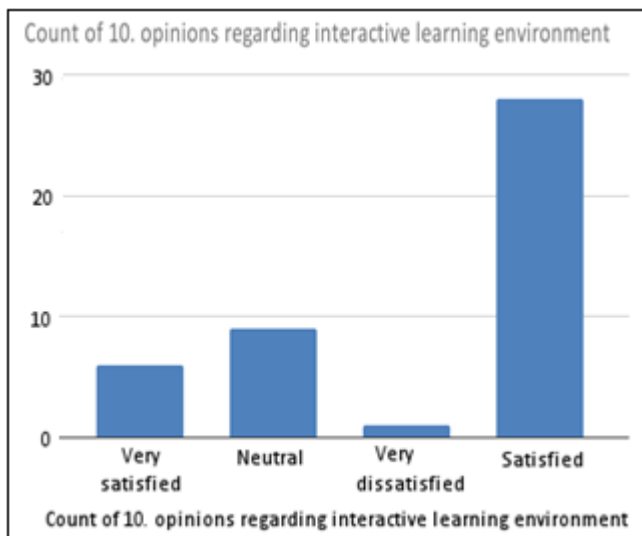
- Time schedule



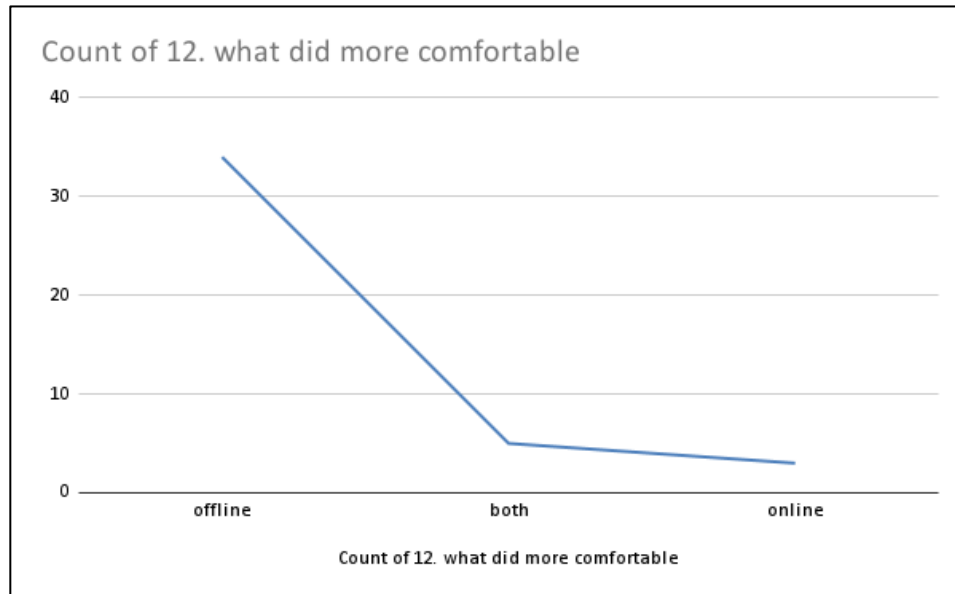
