To study the awareness about Swami Vivekananda and his teachings among the students of Panjab University Chandigarh.


2. Research Methodology

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
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
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Graph 1.2: Showing the responses of the students about from where did they get to know about Swami Vivekananda for the first time



Graph 1.3: Showing the responses of the students about the teachings of Swami Vivekananda



Graph 1.5: Showing the responses of the students:



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
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Graph 1.6: Showing the responses of the students




Graph 1.7: Showing the responses of the students:
