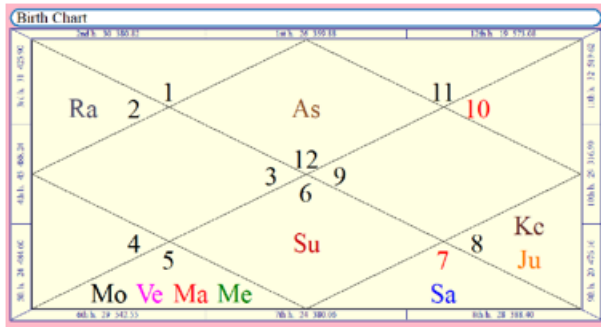

Astrological combinations that represent child sexual abuse are as follows: -

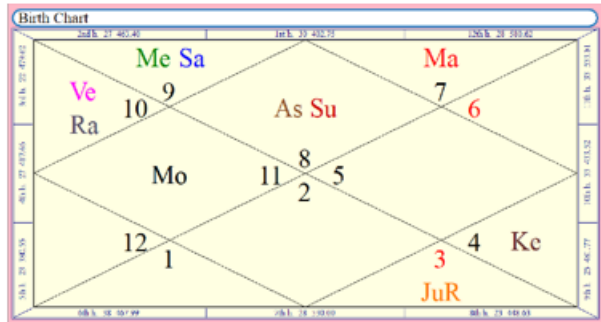
- 1) Sexual abuse is related to the seventh, eighth, twelfth and sixth houses.

- 8) Placement of moon in 6th house, 8th house and 12th house

- 10) Along with the influence of the above combinations, if there is presence of any auspicious planet like Jupiter or any relation with it, then there is a possibility of reduction or protection from exploitation
