

Unravelling the Celestial - Energetic Nexus: A Case Study on the Correlation between Seven Chakras and the Nine Planets

Level of Significance:





Alpha (α) = 0.05




The p - value is less than 0.05, the null hypothesis was rejected, indicating a statistically significant correlation between planetary positions and chakra balance.



Specific Hypotheses:

- 1) There is a positive correlation between the position of the Sun and the balance of the Solar Plexus Chakra ($r > 0$).
- 2) There is a negative correlation between the position of Saturn and the balance of the Root Chakra ($r < 0$).
- 3) There is a significant difference in chakra balance between participants with Jupiter in fire signs (Aries, Leo, Sagittarius) and those with Jupiter in earth signs (Taurus, Virgo, Capricorn).

4. Results







- Root Chakra (Muladhara) correlated with Saturn, representing stability and structure.
- Sacral Chakra (Svadhithana) correlated with Jupiter, representing creativity and expansion.
- Solar Plexus Chakra (Manipura) correlated with Mars, representing energy and drive.
- Heart Chakra (Anahata) correlated with Venus, representing love and harmony.
- Throat Chakra (Vishuddha) correlated with Mercury, representing communication and expression.
- Third Eye Chakra (Ajna) correlated with the Moon, representing intuition and insight.
- Crown Chakra (Sahasrara) correlated with the Sun, representing spiritual awareness and enlightenment.
- Uranus, Neptune, and Pluto correlated with the higher states of consciousness, spiritual awakening, and transformation.

5. Discussion

The findings of this case study suggest a significant correlation between the positions of the nine planets and the balance and imbalanced state of the seven chakras. The seventy five participants belonged to different age groups and occupation. their chakras status was assessed with validated questionnaire and simultaneously their current planetary positions were also studied astrologically. their physical ailments were correlated to their chakras blocked or imbalanced state and the planets affected according to astrology. The results indicate that certain planetary positions are associated with specific chakra imbalances, and that these correlations can be helpful in astrological consultations and

energy healing practices. The study's findings support the idea that the celestial realm has a profound impact on human consciousness and energy. The correlations between planetary positions and chakra balance suggest that the positions of the planets can influence human emotions, thoughts, and behaviours, and that these influences can be understood and worked with energy healing.
