To know the best method for treating charcots diseases of foot.

## 2. Methods & Methodology

All patients with charcots foot were taken for the study from 2015 till 2016(2years) 9cases.7 underwent conservative treatment with good fitting pop cast. Causes were identified; one underwent fusion with implant, one with fusion & BG.

## 3. Results

All Treated Conservatively Gave Best Result	77% (Patients)	Excellent
Fusion With Implants	11.5% (1 Patient)	Bad
Fusion With Bg	11.5%(1patient)	Poor

## 4. Discussions

Patient treated conservatively gave good result than fusion with BG/implant.

## 5. Conclusion

All charcots joints should be treated non surgically, conservatively to get excellent result.
