K. M. Anwarul Islam and Umme Salma(2016) presents in the study that the an exploratory survey was conducted to examine the Contribution in Education of Private University. Laura Romero and Elena del Rey(2004) presents in the study the theoretical model Public and Private University in higher Education. In which a Public and Private University compete for student in the presence of borrowing constraints. It is found the unique equilibrium found in the Public Universities. The authors got the results that the there is higher quality of Education and Admission standard than the Public University.

Sma Zia(2015) presents in the study that in compare the Private and Public schools now a day, parents gives more preference to the Private school. The author use the primary data for data collocation through constructed questionnaire and survey method was applied for collection of data from the target respondents of Private and Public schools. The results show that the educated parents prefer Private schooling for their children.

3. Research Methods

A structured Questionnaire was used in this survey.
