## 4. Result and Discussion

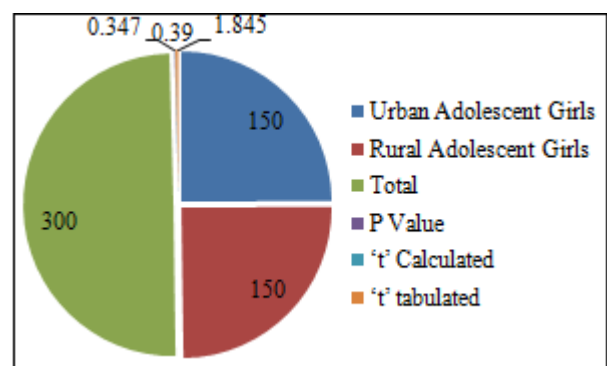
The adolescent's girls in Rural area necessity of knowing everything regarding education of colleges and courses offered. They have fear of attending college for studies.
